

### English

We will start Term 2 reading and responding to a variety of Firework Poetry. The children will begin to use language features such as onomatopoeia and alliteration in their own simple firework poems.

We will be reading the story 'The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark' and using this to help us write our own stories about nocturnal animals.

We will be writing an information leaflet about night and day animals and writing an explanation text about how animals fly.

### Computing

In ICT the children will learn about e-safety. They will watch a series of cartoons which explain how they can stay safe whilst using the internet. They will take part in activities which will teach them about protecting their personal details and stranger danger in the virtual world.

### Religious Education

This term the children will learn about Festivals of Light in different religions. As we approach Christmas, they will learn about Advent, The Story of Christingle and The Nativity Story.

### Science

In Science, the children will observe and recognise some simple characteristics of animals e.g. owls. They will learn that animals are similar to each other in some ways and different in other ways. They will begin to start grouping animals by the key features of their appearance. They will classify animals that are mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians or fish using simple observable features.

The children will also learn about night and day animals and light and dark.



## Curriculum Web Year 1 – Term 2

### Humanities

In History, the children will start the term learning about the story of Guy Fawkes and how this relates to the 5<sup>th</sup> November traditions that they experience today. They will begin to understand the significance of Remembrance Day and the reason why people wear poppies at this time of year.

### Art & DT

In Art the children will represent fireworks using different media.

In DT the children will design and make a Christmas decoration and will make a variety of other Christmas crafts.

### Maths

In Term 2 the children will be able to count forwards and backwards to twenty from any given number. They will compare and order numbers using more, less and fewer. Children will be able to add and subtract numbers within 20. They will be able to add two one digit numbers and subtract a one digit number from a teens number.

### P.E.

P.E this term will be Gymnastics. The children will begin to move fluently, changing direction and speed and creating simple sequences. They will learn simple rolling techniques and find ways to travel along apparatus on different parts of their body. In outdoor P.E. the children will continue to develop and practise their ball skills.

This term the children will be celebrating differences and themselves. They will discuss ways they are the same and different. What is bullying and what do I do about bullying? They will also learn about making new friends and celebrating being themselves.
