Fiction – Traditional tales:

Children will be reading a traditional tale about a wish which they will discuss before planning and writing their own story with a wish.

Non-Fiction – Newspaper report:

We will write a newspaper report using the text 'Into the Forest' by Anthony Brown as a resource.

Discussion:

We will be writing balanced arguments on a range of topics.

Poetry Performance poetry:

Children will explore the poem 'My Iguana' by Brian Moses.
