Maths

This term the children will continue to develop their knowledge of numbers, number patterns and calculations with numbers between 50 and 100. They will also continue to develop their addition and subtraction knowledge with numbers beyond 20. The children will also work within the areas of Length and Mass. They will continue to develop their fluency and accuracy of their arithmetic skills.

Art

This term the children will explore sculpture. They will look at natural objects and make observational drawings of natural objects. They will draw on the inspiration of Andrew Goldsworthy to produce their own sculpture.

Design and Technology

This term the children will design and make a car of their choice. They will begin to identify the different parts of cars and be able to use this information to help with their own design.

Science

In Science, the children will draw and label a plant and then consider how plants can be identified in their environment. They will also learn that all plants have the same main parts but can look different. The children will also learn about forces and in particular look at friction. They will investigate which materials would be best for a ramp and test cars to see which travels the furthest.

Geography

In Geography, the children will be using maps and Atlases to explore the United Kingdom. They will follow Barnaby Bear whilst he travels around visiting the capital cities and other UK landmarks. The children will be given the opportunity to share their own experiences of travel within the UK. They will be focussing on the different modes of transport he uses as he travels around the UK.

PHSE

This term the children will be exploring relationships. They will be learning about families, making friends and people who help us. We will be doing this through circle time activities, stories and role play.

Religious Education

In R.E. the children will continue their learning about Christianity and the stories that Jesus told. They will hear and discuss stories from the bible.

P.E.

Outdoor P.E. this term will be Games. We will be developing the children's hand/eye co-ordination and motor skills through the use of small apparatus such as bats, balls, quoits and beanbags. Indoor P.E. this term will be a mixture of gym and dance – moving in different ways, varying speed and linking movements.
