

English

In term 3 the children will be reading fantasy stories about dinosaurs and develop research skills by using different information sources to learn more about a variety of dinosaur species.

As the term progresses, the children will be writing their own dinosaur adventure stories using a traditional story for inspiration.

During the term, we hope to sprinkle a bit of dinosaur magic to trigger the children's imagination and creativity.

PSHE

This term the children will be learning about Dreams and Goals. They will be thinking about what they are good at and what they want to be good at and how they can achieve their dreams and goals. The children will participate in circle time activities, group discussions and independent activities.

DT/Art

This term the children will learn about 'Textiles'. They will investigate the possibilities of a range of materials and processes. They will experiment with papers, fabrics and paint to create different effects. The children will then make a cardboard loom to weave a wide variety of fabrics, ribbons and yarns to make a beautiful piece of artwork.

Science

In Science the children will be learning to identify and name the basic external parts of the human body and recognise the functions of some body parts, including the sense organs. Children will describe and compare common animals, and will recognise and name a variety of animals and their body parts. They will label a map of the human body and will draw comparisons between human and animal body parts. They will consider how to treat other people and living things with care and respect.



Curriculum Web Year 1 – Term 3 Dinosaur Romp

Humanities

The children will be learning about dinosaurs: when dinosaurs existed and when they became extinct, where they lived on earth, different types of dinosaurs, what they ate, how they moved. The children will find out about how we know so much about dinosaurs now.

Maths

This term the children will be working on exploring calculation strategies within 20. The children will begin to represent numbers within 50 in different ways. They will use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20. They will also add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20 and beyond.
