Curriculum Web Year 1 – Term 6

Ahoy there !

Maths

This term the children will learn about money, to recognise and value coins and notes, and to be able to solve one-step addition/subtraction problems. They will use multiplication and division to solve one-step problems using concrete and pictorial representations and arrays. In capacity and volume, the children will compare, describe, measure, record and solve practical problems. They will also continue to develop their fluency and accuracy of their arithmetic skills.

Art

This term the children will focus on the skill of drawing. The children will look at lines and marks, tone, shape and texture.

Design and Technology

This term the children will continue to design and make a car of their choice. They will begin to identify the different parts of cars and be able to use this information to help with their own design.

Science

In Science, the children will describe the physical properties of a variety of everyday materials. They will compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple properties. They will describe the properties of different materials, for example wood, metal, plastic, rubber, fur, toweling, nylon, wool, sponge, cotton wool, paper, card, brick, ceramics and rock.

History

In History, the children will be looking at the seaside in the past and comparing it to the seaside today. They will look in particular at what the Promenade, the people and the entertainment were like in the past.

The children will also learn about the life of a significant person in history - Grace Darling.

PHSE

This term the children will be discussing and learning about the topic 'changing me'. The areas included in this topic will be – lifecycles, changing me, my changing body, boys and girls' bodies, learning and growing and coping with the changes.

Religious Education

In R.E the children will continue their learning about Christianity and learn about the story of Moses.

P.E.

Outdoor P.E. this term will be Games. We will be developing the children's hand/eye co-ordination and motor skills through the use of small apparatus such as bats, balls, quoits and beanbags. The children will be practising skills needed for Sports Day.
