

## English

### Fiction – Diary

This unit enables the children to write a diary entry from the point of view of a Roman.

### Non-Fiction – Recount and Newspaper

The children will learn about the volcano eruption in Pompeii and report on what happened.

### Poetry – Creating Images

## Science – Health and Nutrition

The children will be learning about the various kinds of teeth and their role in ripping, biting and chewing. They will learn about the basic organs of the digestive system and how food is absorbed into the body. They will create experiments involving their teeth and toothpaste.

## Maths

The children will be learning how to find the area and perimeter of composite and rectilinear shapes. They will be consolidating their knowledge of 3D shapes by applying their understanding of the properties of shapes and solve problems based on 2D presentations of 3D shapes. They will be comparing and classifying various 2D shapes, angles, and identifying lines of symmetry.

## PSHE – Healthy me!

The children will be learning about relationships and different roles in a group. They will also be learning about the effects of alcohol and smoking on their health.

# Curriculum Web Year Four Term 5

## Curriculum Enrichment Topic: The Romans and the Roman Empire

### History

We will focus on the history of the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain, including our local area.

- What have the Romans ever done for us?
- Roman law and order
- Roman roads and towns

### Geography

We will learn the location and the different traits of volcanoes around the world. Children will be able to mark the Ring of Fire on a world map. They will also learn about how the Roman Empire rose and gained land.
