

English

Fiction – Fantasy/Adventure:

This term the children will be reading 'Varjak Paw'. It is a novel by the British author S. F. Said. The novel received the 2003 Smarties Gold Award and has been adapted for other media.

Non-Fiction – Play scripts:

This unit will explore the layout and structure of play scripts, which will result in children creating their own.

Poetry – Imagery and recital:

Children will be analysing 'The Way Through the Woods' by Rudyard Kipling.

PSHE – Health and Well-being

In this unit, children will reflect on and celebrate their achievements, identify their strengths, areas for improvement, set high aspirations and goals. They will develop strategies for keeping physically and emotionally safe, including safety in the environment and safety online.

Excursions / Enrichment

In the first week back, the children will be visiting the Source Park. This will take place during school hours.

Science

In this unit children will continue to learn about the separation techniques of filtering, sieving and evaporation. They will explore dissolving and will use the terms solute and solvent. They will use evaporation to recover dissolved solutes and will recognise that these are reversible changes. Children will be introduced to examples of irreversible changes such as burning candles and other fuels, heating some materials and mixing bicarbonate with acid. They will learn that in these changes new materials are made and that these new materials are often in the form of gases.
