

## English

### **Fiction – Fantasy and adventure**

The children will be studying 'Rooftoppers' by Catherine Rundell – a fantasy set in Paris about an orphaned girl, Sophie, who believes her Mother may have survived a shipwreck. It is full of suspense and drama!

### **Non-Fiction – Recounts and Newspaper Articles**

This term we will be looking at recount texts such as 'How the Body Was Discovered', and distinguishing between fact and opinion.

### **Poetry**

We will be reading 'The Great Water Giant' by Ian Souter.

## Science

They will give reasons, based on evidence from comparative and fair tests, for the particular use of everyday materials, including metals, wood and plastic.
