Carrie's War

This term we will be reading 'Carrie's War' which is a 1973 British children's novel by Nina Bawden, set during the Second World War and following two evacuees, Carrie and her younger brother Nick. It is often read in schools for both its literary and its historical interest. 'Carrie's War' received the 1993 Phoenix Award and has been adapted for television.

Science – Evolution and Inheritance

Pupils will investigate how living things and changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited Earth millions of years ago. They will identify how animals and plants adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution. To work scientifically, pupils will have the opportunity to use secondary sources to research and evaluate evidence about evolution and inheritance. This will include, researching pivotal scientists such as: Mary Anning, Alfred Wallace and Charles Darwin.

Maths

In year 6 we follow the abacus scheme. We will cover:

- Statistics and data
- Negative numbers
- Algebra and ratio
- Decimals, percentages and their equivalent fractions
- Written and mental calculations

P.E.

Children will develop their hand eye co-ordination using a bat and ball. They will be able to work in pairs and against another person. They will also be able to work towards, and compete in, competitive games.

PSHE: Teamwork and respect will be covered.

Curriculum Enrichment Topic: WW2

Children will be able to explain how and why the war started. They will also be able to empathise with evacuees – how they felt leaving their parents/during the blitz/the food they could eat.
