Subject	Recommended activities
<p>Reading</p> 	<p>Purpose: To promote reading for pleasure. It doesn't have to look like the original at all and you could use paints, collage, bubble writing, anything at all! You could also post a photo of you reading your favourite book in your favourite reading place on Eexat.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Purpose: To rehearse key skills and concepts The concept of doubling and halving is really important and there are 5 lessons based on doubling and halving from the Oak Academy here: https://classroom.thenational.academy/units/doubling-and-halving-7730 Of course you could explore these ideas in many different ways over the holiday such as in the kitchen with amounts of food, seeds planted in the garden or amount of minutes spent playing games. You could even think about how many Easter eggs you would have if you gave half away or even got double the amount!</p>
<p>Topic</p> 	<p>Purpose: To prepare for new learning in term 5. Our topics next term are all linked to growth so we would love to see you photograph anything that you have noticed growing when you have been out and about over the holidays. This could be some lambs in a field, some new flowers in bloom or maybe you have or will plant some things of your very own.
