Reading 	<p>Today, you are going to complete a book review for a book you have read at home. It may be one we have used for home learning or one you have read yourself at home.</p> <p>Book reviews are great for recommending books to other people, so they can read them. So, remember to put lots of exciting information in them. On page 3 there is a template for you to use.</p>
Writing 	<p>If you didn't finish it yesterday, then finish writing your five part-story. Remember my example is on Wednesday's home learning.</p> <p>If you have finished it then today is a chance to edit your work. All great authors edit their work when they finish writing. Check your spellings and punctuation. Are there any extra words you could add in to make your story more exciting? Could you add some expanded noun phrase in?</p> <p><u>Extension</u> If you have finished this then on page 4 there is a minibeast Wordsearch for you to complete.</p>

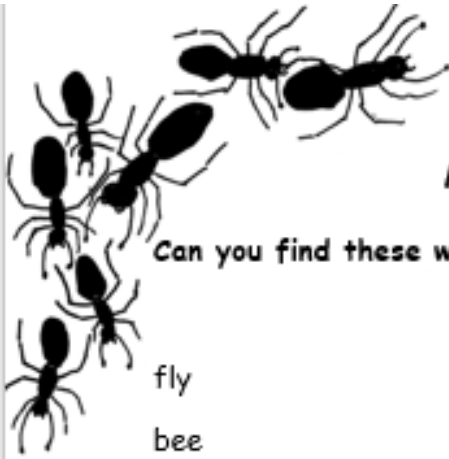

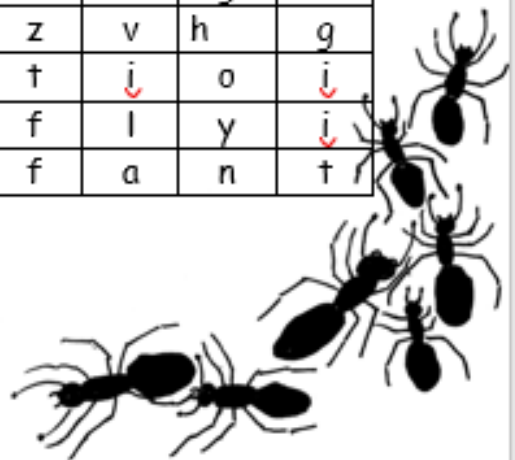

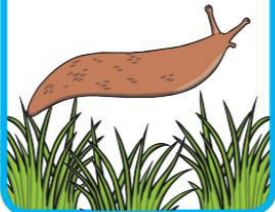
