Charlie and Lola: My Best, Best Friend


When we get home from school, I say "What's wrong Lola?"

PSHE – The people who help us

Yesterday we had a look at the different people that help us.

We thought about the different jobs and if we know anyone with these jobs.



How do these people help us?

Teachers and librarians help us learn. We need to learn so that we can have the jobs we want and understand the world around us.

Dentists, doctors, nurses, vets and ambulance people all keep us and our pets healthy and help us if we get hurt.

Police officers, mountain rescuers, lifeguards, fire fighters, lollipop people, SES officers and lunchtime supervisors all keep us safe as we go about our daily tasks.

Builders, road workers and mechanics make sure that our cars and machines work properly, and that we have buildings to live and play in, and roads to travel on.

Taxi drivers and bus drivers help us to get to where we need to be.

Garbage collectors and janitors (we often call them 'bin men' and 'cleaners' in England) are the people who keep the streets and public places clean.

Postal workers and delivery workers (including milk deliverers) help us send and receive parcels and letters.

All of these people help us and our community. Without them it would be difficult for us to live a safe and happy life. Draw yourself or a family member as one of the people who help us and explain your choice. You can use the word mat on page 4 and my example answer to help you.
