

Steam Trains

The first steam locomotive carried goods not people.



The first public train station used a steam train. The steam train carried people between different towns and cities. It travelled at 24mph. It was invented by a British man called George Stephenson in about 1825.



The Flying Scotsman

The Flying Scotsman was a steam train that took passengers from Scotland to England.

As it was a steam train, it used coal that was burned to create steam that powered the train.

The Flying Scotsman travelled at 100mph and was used in 1925!



Diesel Train

Diesel trains are what we use now. They are much faster than the steam trains were.

They have an engine just like a car and can take passengers to lots of different places.

Eurostar

The Eurostar travels at 180mph!

It takes passengers to different countries like France and Belgium.

It was introduced in 1994.
