

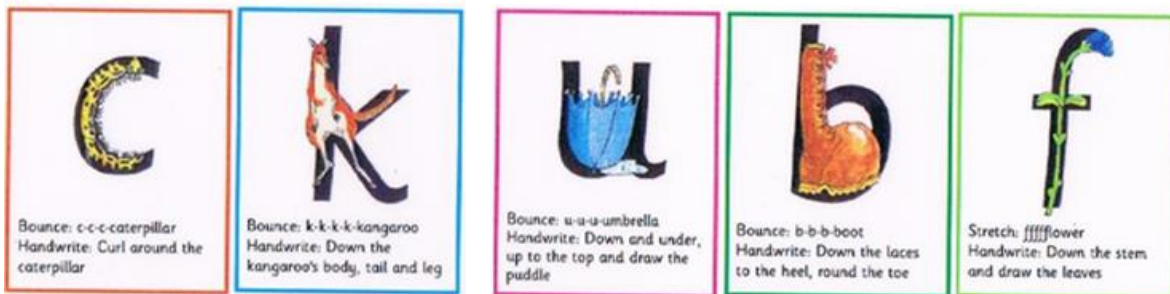
Introduction to Read Write Inc. Phonics

Dear Parents and carers,

This week during our daily phonics lessons the children have been learning the new sounds c, k, u, b and f. The image and handwriting phrase helps the children remember each sound.



Working with your child to practice recognising each sound will help them make speedy progress in phonics. Reading to your child daily is also a great tool for developing a love of reading which is essential for success in phonics.

The children are developing early reading skills by reading short words such as 'cat' 'bag' or 'pen'. We call these 'CVC words' because they are made up of consonant, vowel, consonant. When the children read a CVC word they first identify each sound and say the sounds out loud: e.g. c-a-t, then the children blend the sounds together to read the whole word. e.g. c-a-t cat.
