





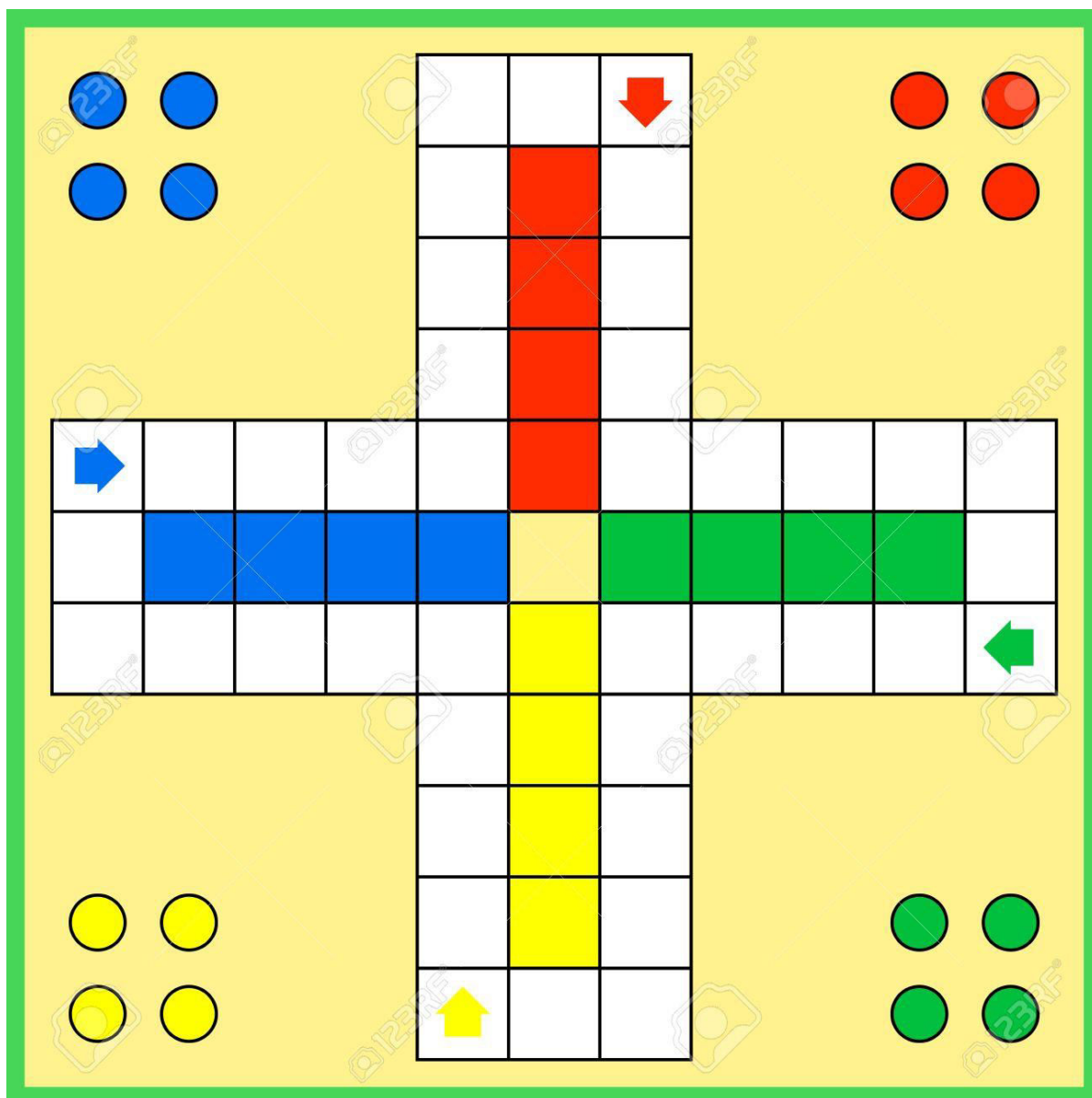
Monday 13th July 2020 <u>Home Learning – Year 2 -Term 6- Week 7 – Monday</u>
