Maybe get an adult or sibling to ask you the questions so you can really get into character Use the knowledge you have learnt about royals and castles over the last few weeks. Helpful tip: <i>Remember the life of a king or queen is very different to ours. Royal people speak in a formal voice. Answer as if you are them and not you.</i>

Questions

- 1) What royal duties do you have to carry out?

Answers

Topic

What you need to make your evil potion:

First things first, remember to ask an adult for permission before using anything around the house or garden.

Instructions

- Ask a grown up for an old pot. It can be any pot.
- If you have a garden, go outside and collect sticks, leaves, flowers, weeds or anything you think would be useful for your evil potion and place into the pot.
- If you do not have a garden go around your house and see what you could use for your evil potion. Maybe washing up liquid, shampoo, ketchup or anything else you think would make your potion evil.
- The next step is to add water and mix it all together. Stir it carefully and make sure it's all mixed in.
- Finally, you need to think of some magic words you can say while stirring the pot to make sure the evil plan works e.g. hubble, bubble boil and trouble.
