<p>Reading</p> 	<p>This week we are looking at poetry that rhymes. Read this poem and write down the words that rhyme. Here is an example of two words that rhyme: 'cow' and 'now'. Here is another example from the poem this time: 'Mars' and 'stars'. Remember to include all our steps to success: capital letters, full stops, finger spaces, adjectives (big, small, amazing, scary), suffixes (-est -er) and conjunctions (And, but, because, so).</p> <p>Spellings- Please ask an adult or older sibling to test you on your spellings today.</p> <p>Our words this week are: voice, choice, void, noise, coin</p>


Purple Mash: Don't forget to check you 2Dos on Purple Mash!

Geography

In Scotland they have haggis, black bun, scotch eggs, smoked salmon and shortbread biscuits.

Haggis is made out of sheep organs, onion, oatmeal and herbs and spices. It is a traditional meal that is eaten during celebrations in Scotland.



In Northern Ireland they have foods like Irish stew, corned beef and cabbage, boxty and soda bread.

Boxty and soda bread is a traditional potato pancake.

In Wales they have leeks, Welsh rarebit and Welsh cakes.

Welsh cakes are a type of thick pancake that has dried fruit in. Rarebit is a savoury sauce of melted cheese and various other ingredients that is poured over toasted bread.
