

This week at school we have learnt to read and write the sounds c, k, u, b and f. Practicing writing these sounds at home will help your child to remember this new skill. Ask your child to trace over the grey letters and then have a go at writing each letter independently at the bottom of the page.

You can challenge your child by asking them to spot each sound when you are reading books together.

We use rhymes to remember how each letter is formed:






C – curl around the caterpillar

k – down the kangaroo’s body, tail and leg

u – down and under, up to the top and draw the puddle

b – down the laces to the heel, round the toe

f – down the stem and draw the leaves
